WHAT CHURCHES & MOSQUES CAN DO

- Governing councils can pass a resolution calling upon its congregants to vote.
- Ask your pastors or imams to form a committee to encourage voting within the congregation.
- Pastors and imams can devote a monthly sermon to the importance of voting.
- Church pastors can organize a breakfast with other members of the Black clergy and create a project to turn out the Black religious vote.
- Church and Muslim leaders can host a press conference announcing their plans to get out the vote.
- Churches and mosques can organize a canvass providing important information to citizens about voting.
- Churches and mosques can host a legislative breakfast with local elected officials to secure their support for their efforts to get out the vote.
- Churches and mosques can ask their denomination leaders to endorse their efforts.
- Churches and mosques can encourage members of its congregations to write letters, make phone calls and door knock to get out the vote.
- Churches and mosques can host a wide variety of events to turn out people and register voters.
- Churches and mosques can host a poor people’s dinner to highlight the crisis of poverty and the importance of voting.
- Ask each church or mosques to put together get out the vote activities for the GOTV weekend.
- Churches and mosques can host motorcades through neighborhoods to get people out to vote.
- Churches and mosques can host special Heritage Day events honoring those who voted and the ancestors that made it all possible.
- Churches and mosques can host a voter registration drive.
